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Day 1 • Check In Seorak Hanwha Resort : 4 • Lunch, Dinner

Incheon

For Guest Arrival with Morning flight : D7506 / ETA 0820, KE672 / ETA 0655, MH66 / ETA 0710

- Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, Local tour guide will meet guests on 09:30 am at “ GATE A ” . After that, Tour will start with transferring
  - Nami Island
    - Namiseom Island, most commonly referred to as Nami Island, is a popular tourist attraction and somewhat of a curiosity just northeast of Seoul. See where the drama 'Winter Sonata' was filmed on Nami Island, and walk through one of the most famous gardens in Korea.
  - Garden of Morning Calm
    - The Garden of Morning Calm is an arboretum located at the

east of Seoul, in the Gapyeong district of South Korea. On 300,000 m<sup>2</sup>, it houses 5,000 species of plants, some rare or endangered.

Everland - Seoul

- After Breakfast, Visit to
  - Mt.Sorak National Park
    - South Korea's third-highest mountain. As you explore with your fun and knowledgeable guide, see why this UNESCO-protected mountain is one of the country's most popular destinations, named for its slowly melting covering of snow. In November 1965, the Seorak Mountain district was designated as a Natural Monument preservation area. Afterwards in December 1973, it was designated as a park preservation area, and in August 1982, as a Biosphere Preservation District by UNESCO.
  - Shinheungsa Temple
    - Sinheungsa, sometimes spelled Shinheungsa, is a head temple of the Jogye Order of Korean Buddhism. It is situated on the slopes of Seoraksan in Sokcho, Gangwon Province, South Korea. Sinheungsa is located in Seoraksan National Park, and many tourists hiking Seoraksan up to Ulsanbawi pass by the temple on the way
  - Everland Theme Park , enjoy 1 Day Pass with Safari World
    - Everland Resort entertains visitors all year long with various rides, festivals, theme areas, and Zootopia, perfect for a great amusement park. One of the park's most famous rides is T-Express, Korea's first wooden roller coaster, popular among young visitors. Along with its main attractions, Everland includes a zoo and water park known as Carribbean Bay

- After Breakfast, Visiy
  - Deoksugung Palace
    - Deoksugung, also known as Gyeongun-gung, Deoksugung

Palace, or Deoksu Palace, is a walled compound of palaces in Seoul that was inhabited by members of Korea's royal family during the Joseon monarchy until colonial period around the turn of the 20th century.

- Pine Tree Gallery
  - This 600-year-old pine tree stands at the entrance to Songnisan Mountain in Boeun-gun, Chungcheongbuk-do. This old tree, designated as Natural Monument No. 103, is 15 meters in height and 4.5 meters in girth. Its branches stretch 10.3 meters to the east, 9.6 meters to the west and 10 meters to the north. Shaped like an open umbrella, this pine tree has long been the symbol of Songnisan Mountain, and has even been awarded the title of a Jeongipum grade official of the Joseon Court.
- Kimchi DIY with wearing Hanbok and Seaweed Museum
  - Learn the art of wearing 'hanbok,' traditional Korean attire, and discover how to make Kimchi during this cultural experience. Visit the Bukchon Hanok Village, Samcheongdong Road and Insa-dong Street, plus try to make Kimchi, wear a traditional Korean dress.
- Bukchon Hanok Village,
  - Bukchon Hanok Village is a Korean traditional village in Seoul with a long history located on the top of a hill between Gyeongbok Palace, Changdeok Palace and Jongmyo Royal Shrine. The traditional village is composed of lots of alleys, hanok and is preserved to show a 600-year-old urban environment.
- Myeongdong Street with Duty Free Shop
  - Myeong-dong is one of the primary shopping districts in Seoul. Unlike Namdaemun or Dongdaemun, many designer brands are sold in Myeong-dong
- Shopping stop at Herbal Shop , Skin Care Experience, Ginseng Shop and Cosmetic Shop

Jeju Island

- After Breakfast, visit
  - Namsangol Hanok Village
    - Namsangol Hanok Village, also known as "A Village of Traditional Houses in the Namsan Valley", is a Korean village located in the area of Pil-dong neighborhood in Jung-gu, a central district of Seoul,

- Shinchonlady's street.
- Transfer to Jeju using domestic flight at Gimpo airport. Upon arrival at Jeju airport, transfer to
  - Yongduam Rock
    - Popular oceanfront volcanic rock formation in the shape of a dragon's head.
- Check in Hotel.



Day 5 • Check In Jeju Roboro : 4 • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Jeju Island

- After Breakfast, Visit
  - Mysterious road
    - Also known as Dokkaebi Road, lies on a hill at the foot of a mountain, and connects two major highways on Jeju Island. It has earned its name, as objects and liquid appear to roll rendered by the seemingly high surroundings.
  - Seongsan Ilchulbong.[UNESCO World Heritage]
    - Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak rose from under the sea in a volcanic eruption over 100,000 years ago. Located on the eastern end of Jeju Island, there is a huge crater at the top of Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak. The crater is about 600m in diameter and 90m high. With the 99 sharp rocks surrounding the crater, it looks like a gigantic crown. While the southeast and north sides are cliffs, the northwest side is a verdant grassy hill that is connected to the Seongsan Village. The ridge provides an ideal spot for walks and for horse riding as well. The sunrise from the crater is magnificent. Also the Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak surrounded by bright yellow colored canola flowers in the spring is truly a sight to behold.
- After than, transfer to
  - Seongeup village
    - Seongeup Folk Village is a small town that holds a vast amount of culture. Cultural properties in the folk village have been handed down from generation to generation and include treasures such as residential houses, Confucian shrines and schools, ancient government offices, stone statues, large millstones (pulled by horses or ox), fortress ruins, and stone monuments. Among the cultural gems of the folk village are intangible cultural assets such as folk plays, native foods, local folk craftsmanship, and local dialect. Even the trees are an important part of the area's heritage. Several zelkova and nettle trees that are hundreds of years old stand at the center of the village, preserving the dignified atmosphere of a bygone era.

- Oedolgae
  - Oedolgae Rock, 20 m in height, is the first thing that you will see when you look at the rocks surrounding Namju's Haegeumgang River and the Seogwipo Chilshipri Coast. About 2 km away to the west of Seogwipo City there is Sammaebong Parasitic Volcano and Oedolgae Rock, which stands on a beautiful shore near the mountain, and was formed when a volcano erupted and changed the island's landscape about 150,000 years ago. Since it is a strong rock carved by wave erosion, it is called a sea stack. At the peak of the island, there are pine trees that are regenerating.
- Teseum safari
  - Teseum Safari is a new concept museum, the first of its kind in the world, exhibiting stitched dolls shaped like wildlife animals, marine animals, flowers, birds and more. The wild animal zone on the first floor has a photo zone for visitors to take photos with lions, tigers, and elephants along with teddy bears. On the second floor, varied animal dolls like dolphins, sharks and marine animals such as octopus, turtle, flamingo, crane, and a flock of ducks are available. On the second floor of Building B, a 4m-tall teddy bear is available for children to play with by running around freely at the playground, as well as watching all the teddy bears appearing in a teddy drama "New Heart." Teseum Art Gallery shows movie parody teddy bear, Greek mythology parody teddy bear, and world costume teddy bears. A gift shop sells various teddy bear goods and lovely teddy bears. A restaurant in the basement sells handmade pizza with personalized toppings is available. In particular, wish trees located throughout Building A on the first and second floors can be a special event for tourists.
- Cheongjiyeon Falls.
  - Cheongjiyeon Waterfall is a waterfall on Jeju Island, South Korea. Literally, the name Cheongjiyeon means sky connected with land. It is one of the main tourist attractions on Jeju-do. It is 22 m high and 12 m wide.
